AUDITION/INTERVIEW REQUIREMENTS (Fall 2010)

Brass – Graduate Bass Trombone

All graduate applicants should prepare:

Candidates should be able to demonstrate all major and minor scales, covering two or more octaves as possible.

5-8 minutes of contrasting selections from the candidate's current repertoire of solos, etudes and/or excerpts.

Candidates may also be asked to demonstrate sight-reading ability.

Doctoral applicants should expect a 20-25 minute audition/interview.

DM candidates are required to submit with their application a prescreening recording (CD or DVD) a maximum of 20 minutes in length, containing repertoire of the candidate's choice, demonstrating current performance achievement in solo repertoire and common ensemble excerpts. Applicants are encouraged to use the highest quality equipment practically available to most accurately demonstrate current playing level. The recording must be accompanied by a detailed CV and Statement of Intent.
