AUDITION REQUIREMENTS (Fall 2010)

Bachelor of Science in Music and an Outside Field (B.S.O.F.)

All undergraduate applicants should prepare:

A melodious etude (to demonstrate good sound, solid intonation, and musicianship);

A study (to demonstrate technical facility);

All major scales; and

Any solo of your choice. Applicants will also be asked to demonstrate sight-reading ability. Recommended etudes: Arban's Complete Conservatory Method for trumpet or trombone; Blazevich, 70 Studies; Bordogni/Rochut, Melodious Etudes for the Trombone, vol. 1; Kopprasch, 60 Selected Studies; and Tyrell, Advanced Etudes for Trombone. Recommended solos: Capuzzi, Andante and Rondo; Clarke, The Bride of the Waves; Guilman, Morceau symphonique for trombone; Handel, Aria con variazioni for trumpet; Philip Sparke, Pantomime; and Donald White, Lyric Suite.
